The home context for speakership will be used to inform development of the home-based curriculum to ensure that it is effective for the environments in which it is being used. This person will introduce the speakers to the project, soliciting participants to become the pilot group of speaker-learner pairs. First Language speaker is preferred.

Qualifications:

- Lakota Language Studies Degree preferred;
- Have knowledge of the Pine Ridge Sioux Indian Reservation, past/present histories of the Oglala Lakota Oyate, and Lakota Language instructional practices, skills and expertise;
- Two or more years' experience working in an Elementary and/or Middle School classroom.
